



Easy Crochet Triangle Shawl

Finished Sizes

70" [178 cm] wide x 43" [109 cm] tall at center point

Materials

- 525 yds(200g) of worsted weight (CYCA 4, Medium) yarn
- (Model shown in Red Heart Roll With It Melange in the color Paparazzi - 2 skeins)
- Crochet hook size J/10 (6.0mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

11 sts and 6 rows = 4" in dc

Gauge is not critical for this pattern; however, a different gauge will affect size of shawl and amount of yarn used.

Notes

- Ch 3 counts as 1 dc throughout.
- Ch 5 counts as (1 dc, ch 2) throughout.

Special Stitches

Shell = 5 dc in designated st/sp

Instructions

Ch 4.

Row 1: (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in 4th ch from hook. Ch 3, turn. 6 dc

Row 2: Dc in first dc, dc in each dc to ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to last dc, 2 dc in last dc. Ch 3, turn. 12 dc

Rows 3 – 5: Rep Row 2. 30 dc after Row 5.

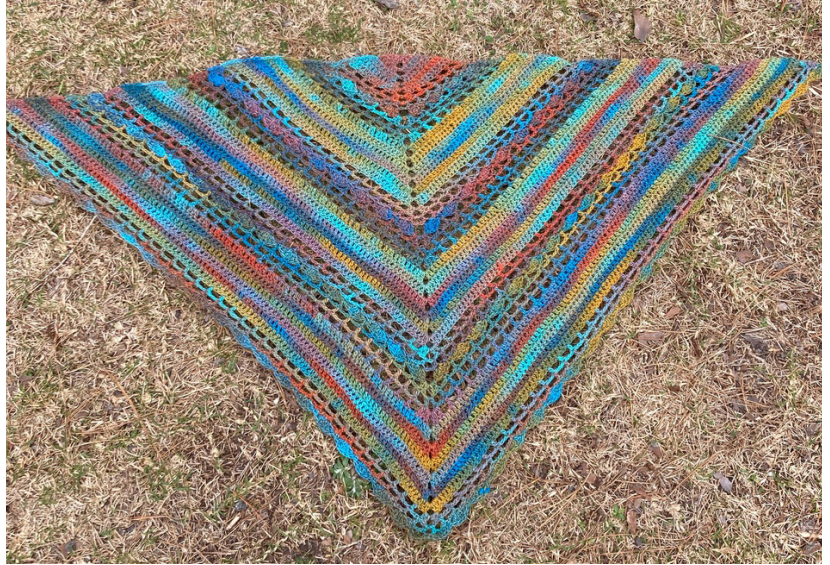
Row 6: Dc in first dc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, *ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc. Rep from * across until 2 dc remain before ch-3 sp, ch 2, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, **ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc. Rep from ** across to last dc, place a second dc in last dc. Ch 3, turn. 10 ch-2 sps + 1 ch-3 sp

Abbreviations

beg: beginning
ch: chain
dc: double crochet
sc: single crochet
sk: skip
sl st: slip st
sp(s): space(s)
st(s): stitch(es)

Row 7: Dc in each of first 2 dc, *ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from * across until 1 dc remains before ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 1 dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, **ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from ** across, 2 dc in last dc. Ch 1, turn. 12 ch-2 sps + 1 ch-3 sp

Row 8: Sc in first dc, sk 1 dc, shell in next dc, *sc in next dc, shell in next dc. Rep from * across to ch-3 sp, ch 3, shell in next dc, **sc in next dc, shell in next dc. Rep from ** across until 2 dc remain, sk 1 dc, sc in last dc. Ch 3, turn. 8 shells + 8 sc



dc.

Row 9: Dc in first sc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, *ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next sc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc. Rep from * across to last shell, ch 2, sk 2 dc, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc, **ch 2, sk 2 dc, dc in next sc, ch 2, sk 2 dc, sc in next dc. Rep from ** across to last shell, ch 2, sk 2 dc, 2 dc in last dc. Ch 3, turn. 16 ch-2 sps + 1 ch-3 sp

Row 10: Dc in each of first 2 dc, *ch 2, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from * until 1 dc remains before ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk next dc, (dc, ch 3, dc) in ch-3 sp, ch 2, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, **ch 2, dc in next sc, ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from ** to end, 2 dc in last dc. Ch 5, turn. 18 ch-2 sps + 1 ch-3 sp

Row 11: Sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, *ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from * to ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, dc in next dc, **ch 2, dc in next dc. Rep from * across until 2 dc remain, ch 2, sk 1 dc, dc in last dc. Ch 3, turn. 20 ch-2 sps + 1 ch-3 sp

Row 12: Dc in first sc, *2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc in next dc. Rep from * across until 2 dc remain before ch-3 sp. Dc in each of those 2 dc, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in ch-3 sp, dc in each of next 3 dc, **2 dc in next ch-2 sp, dc next dc. Rep from * across to end, placing last dc in 3rd ch of beg-ch-5. Ch 3, turn. 72 dc + 1 ch-3 sp

Rows 13 – 17: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 6 – 17 twice then Rows 6 – 8 once more. End off.

Finishing:

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.
