





SPARKLING NEW YEAR'S MYSTERY Fabric & Supply List

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A (Light) 1¾ yds
Fabric B (Medium) 1 yd
Fabric C (Medium Dark) 1½ yds
Fabric D (Dark) 1¼ yds
Binding 5½ yd
Backing 3½ yds

RECOMMENDED SUPPLIES

Clearly Perfect Slotted Trimmer – One Alignment Two Cuts

Quilter's Magic Wand

Martelli Rotating Turntable 3-piece Set,

Rotary cutter with new rotary blade (Recommend Stitchin' Heaven branded)

Neutral thread

Sewing machine and general notions

Quilting pins

Creative Grids 8.5" X 24" Ruler

Spray starch (Best Press recommended)

Seam ripper

Thread snips (Stitchin' Heaven 5" Scissors)

Cutting mat

Stitchin' Heaven Wool Mat

Steam iron

Stitchin' Heaven Block Thread Cutter

Marking pen/pencil (Sewline or Frixion)







CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Label pieces for easy reference. Use a Martelli rotating cutting mat when cutting squares diagonally.

FROM FABRIC A (LIGHT)

Cut (9) 5¾" x WOF strips; Sub-cut into (61) 5¾" x 5¾" Square 4

Cut (3) 2%" x WOF strips;

Sub-cut into (36) 2%" x 2%", cut once diagonally to yield (72) Triangle 3



FROM FABRIC B (MEDIUM)

Cut (4) 5¾" x WOF strips; Sub-cut into (27) 5¾" x 5¾" **Square 5**

Cut (2) 3¼" x WOF strips;

Sub-cut into (18) 3¼" x 3¼", cut twice diagonally to yield (72) Triangle 1



FROM FABRIC C (MEDIUM DARK)

Cut (2) 3¼" x WOF strips; Sub-cut into (18) 3¼" x 3¼", cut twice diagonally to yield (72) Triangle 2



Cut (6) 4½" x WOF strips, sew together end-to-end; Sub-cut into (2) 4½" x 59½" Outer Side Borders

AND (2) 4½" x 51½" Outer Top/Bottom Borders

FROM FABRIC D (DARK)

Cut (5) 5¾" x WOF strips; Sub-cut into (34) 5¾" x 5¾" Square 6

Cut (6) 2" x WOF strips, sew together end-to-end; Sub-cut into (2) 2" x 56%" Inner Side Borders AND (2) 2" x 43%" Inner Top/Bottom Borders

FROM BINDING FABRIC

Cut (7) 2½" x WOF strips, sew together end-to-end using diagonal seams



PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Line up the center line of a Quilter's Magic Wand diagonally from corner to corner on the back of each **Square 4**. Use a Frixion pen or Sewline pencil to draw a line along each side of the Quilter's Magic Wand. Repeat in the opposite diagonal direction.
- Lay out a Square 5 right side up. Place a marked Square 4 right side down on top of Square 5.
 Pin to hold in place. Repeat for all (27) Square 5.
- 3. Lay out a Square 6 right side up. Place a marked **Square 4** right side down on top of **Square 6**. Pin to hold in place. Repeat for all **(34) Square 6**.














- 1. Sew a Triangle 1 to a Triangle 2, oriented as shown to make Unit 1.
- 2. Make a total of (72) Unit 1.






Make 72

- 3. Sew a **Triangle 3** to a **Unit 1**, oriented as shown to make a **Unit 2**. Trim corners.
- 4. Make a total of (72) Unit 2.





UNIT 2 Make 72







1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of all **(61) Square 4**. Draw a second diagonal line between opposite corners of each square.



2. Lay out a **Square 5** right side up. Place a marked **Square 4** right side down on top of **Square 5**. Pin to hold in place. Repeat for all **(27) Square 5**.



3. Lay out a **Square 6** right side up. Place a marked **Square 4** right side down on top of **Square 6**. Pin to hold in place. Repeat for all **(34) Square 6**.



4. Sew ¼" away from each side of both diagonal lines on all pairs of squares. Remove pins.



5. Lay squares on a rotating cutting mat and cut vertically through the center.



6. Without moving the fabric, rotate the mat and cut horizontally through the center.



7. Rotate the mat and cut diagonally through the center.



8. Rotate the mat and cut on the opposite diagonal through the center.



9. Press Half Square Triangle (HST) Units open. Trim corners.



10. You should now have (216) Unit 3 HSTs and (272) Unit 4 HSTs.









1. Arrange (4) Unit 2 and (12) Unit 3 HSTs as shown.



2. Sew units together into rows.



- 3. Sew rows together to complete **Block A**.
- 4. Make a total of (18) Block A.




BLOCK A Make 18









1. Arrange (16) Unit 4 HSTs as shown.



2. Sew units together into rows.



- 3. Sew rows together.
- 4. Make a total of (17) Block B.




Make 17







- 1. Beginning with **Block A** at upper left corner, lay out blocks in **(7) rows** of **(5) blocks each**, alternating **Block A** and **Block B** as shown.
- 2. Sew blocks into rows.
- 3. Sew rows together to complete **Quilt Center**.










- 1. Sew a 2" x 56½" Inner Side Border to each side of the Quilt Center.
- 2. Sew a 2" x 43%" Inner Top/Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 3. Sew a 4½" x 59½" Outer Side Border to each side of the quilt.
- 4. Sew a 4½" x 51½" Outer Top/Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 5. Cut backing fabric into (2) 63" X WOF lengths. Trim selvages off before sewing together to avoid buckling. Sew backing pieces together along the length of fabric to make backing approx. 63" wide x 84" long.
- 6. Quilt, bind, and ENJOY!
