

## Christmas Trees and Candy Canes

### Cutting:

From the **White** fabric, cut:

- **(4)** 10 ½" x 18 ½" rectangles and **(4)** 10 ½" squares

From the **Light Grey** fabric, cut:

- **(4)** 5 7/8" squares

### Assembly:

- On the wrong side of the light grey squares, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. With right sides together, place a marked light grey square on one corner of a white square. Sew on the drawn line. Trim seam allowance to ¼" and press towards the light grey square. Repeat with the remaining marked light grey squares and white squares.
- Sew a white 10 ½" x 18 ½" rectangle to two opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams towards rectangles.
- Paying attention to orientation, (grey triangles facing out) sew a white/light grey square to each end of a white 10 ½" x 18 ½" rectangle. Press seams towards rectangle. Repeat to make a matching row.
- Paying attention to orientation, sew a row to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams to one side.
- Download and print out the **Tree** templates. Trace each template section onto the paper side of fusible web 8 times. Roughly cut out around the traced lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fusible web to the wrong side of the Tree fabric. Cut out along the traced lines.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, and using the finished quilt photo for reference, fuse the Trees to the squares and rectangles previously attached. Place the tree trunk first, followed by the largest tree section and then work towards the top, overlapping each tree section slightly. Stitch the perimeter of each Tree piece using your preferred applique stitch.
- Download and print out the **Candy Cane** templates. Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web 8 times (4 right and 4 left facing Candy Canes). Roughly cut out around the traced lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fusible web to the wrong side of the Candy Cane fabric. Cut out along the traced lines.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, and using the finished quilt photo for reference, fuse the Candy Canes to the corner squares previously attached. Place the main candy cane first and then add the small accents. Stitch the perimeter of each Candy Cane piece using your preferred applique stitch.
