

## Santa, Reindeer and Sleigh

### Cutting:

From the **Dark Grey** fabric, cut:

- **(4)** 8 ½" squares

From the **Light Grey** fabric, cut:

- **(8)** 8 ½" x 15 ½" rectangles and **(4)** 8 ½" squares

### Assembly:

- Sew a light grey 8 ½" x 15 ½" rectangle to both sides of a dark grey 8 ½" square. Press seams towards the dark grey square. Repeat with the remaining light grey rectangles and dark grey squares to make four matching short rows.
- Sew a light grey 8 ½" square to both ends of one of the previously pieced short rows. Press seam towards square. Repeat to make a matching long row.
- Sew a short row to two opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams towards quilt center.
- Sew a long row to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams towards row.
- Download and print out the **Santa, Sleigh and Reindeer** templates. Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web 4 times for the Santa, 4 times for the Sleigh and 16 times for the Reindeer. Roughly cut out around the traced lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric for each of these shapes. Cut out along the traced lines.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, and using the finished quilt photo for reference, fuse the Santa, Sleigh and Reindeer shapes to the squares and rectangles previously attached. For Santa, place the face section first, then position the beard underneath, overlapping slightly. In the following order, add the mouth section, the mustache and the nose, overlapping where needed. Add the eye and eye glint pieces. Position the main hat piece first and then add the hat accents, overlapping slightly. For the sleigh, place the main sleigh piece first and then add the accents, overlapping the top accent slightly and tucking the bottom accent under the main sleigh piece slightly. For the reindeer, place the reindeer first, and then add the antlers, tucking them slightly under the reindeer. Stitch the perimeter of each shape using your preferred applique stitch.
