

Small Snowflake and Holly Berry

Cutting:

From the **Dark Grey** fabric, cut:

- **(6)** 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips short ends together to form one long strip.

From the long strip, cut:

- **(4)** 5 ½" x 54 ½" strips and **(4)** 5 ½" squares



Assembly:

- Sew a 5 ½" square to both ends of a 5 ½" x 54 ½" strip. Press seams towards strip. Repeat with another strip and the remaining squares.
- Sew a 5 ½" x 54 ½" strip to both sides of the quilt center. Press seams towards strips.
- Sew the remaining strips with the 5 ½" squares to the top and bottom.
- Download and print out the **Holly Berry** templates. Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web 8 times for the leaves and 12 times for the berries. Roughly cut out around the traced lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fusible web to the wrong side of the Holly Berry fabric. Cut out along the traced lines.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, and using the finished quilt photo for reference, fuse the Holly Berries to the corner squares previously attached. Place the leaves first and then add the berries, overlapping the pieces slightly. Stitch the perimeter of each Holly Berry using your preferred applique stitch.
- Download and print out the **Snowflake** templates. Trace the templates onto the paper side of fusible web 20 times for each Snowflake. Roughly cut out around the traced lines. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the fusible web to the wrong side of the Snowflake fabric. Cut out along the traced lines.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, and using the finished quilt photo for reference, fuse the Snowflake to the border strips previously attached. Stitch the perimeter of each Snowflake using your preferred applique stitch.
