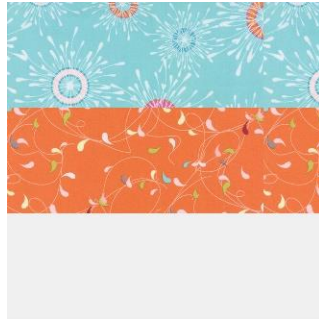


Week 6

Block A (Make 4)



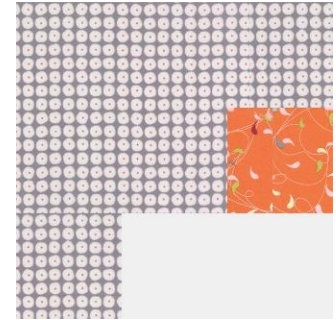
Block B (Make 8)

Cutting Instruction are for all Week 6 Blocks (A, B, C and D)

From **Fabric 1**, cut:

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (**8**) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles, (**8**) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (**4**) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 2**, cut:

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (**12**) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles and (**4**) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

From **Fabric 3**, cut:

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, then sub- cut into (**8**) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles, (**4**) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (**12**) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 4**, cut:

-(**3**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (**8**) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles, (**8**) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (**8**) 2 ½" squares.

**Assembly for Block A**

-Stitch together one **Fabric 1** 2 ½" square and one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square. Press towards the darker fabric. Stitch one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to the stitched squares as shown. Press towards **Fabric 3**.



-Stitch one **Fabric 2** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to the left side of the pieces from the previous step as shown. Press towards **Fabric 2**.

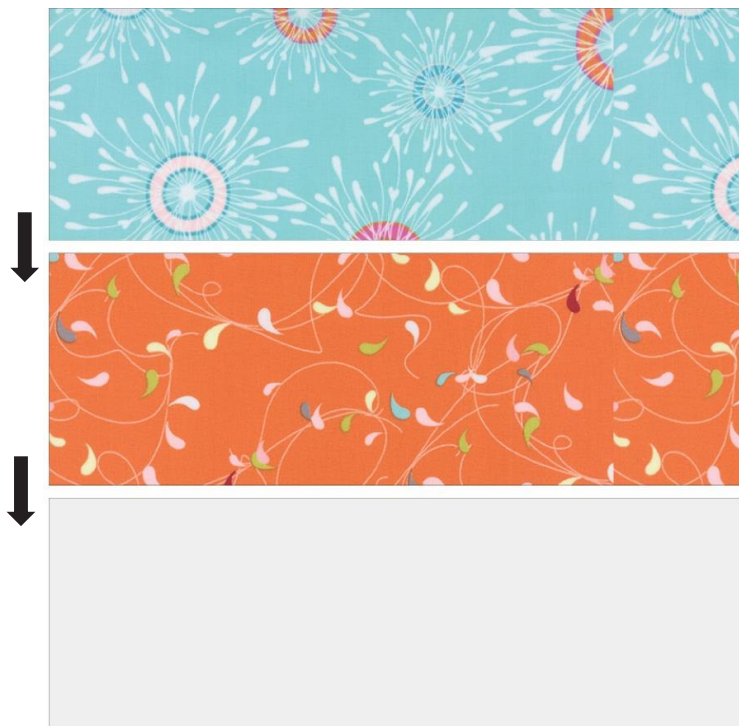


-Stitch one **Fabric 2** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to the top of the pieces from the previous step. Press towards **Fabric 2**. Block should measure 6 ½". Repeat to make four blocks.



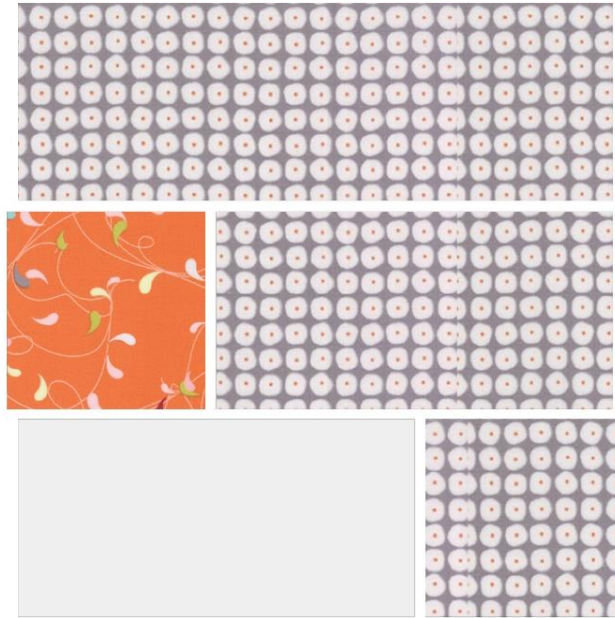
#### Assembly for Block B

-Lay out one **Fabric 1** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle, one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle and one **Fabric 2** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle as shown. Stitch together and press in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 6 ½". Repeat to make eight blocks.

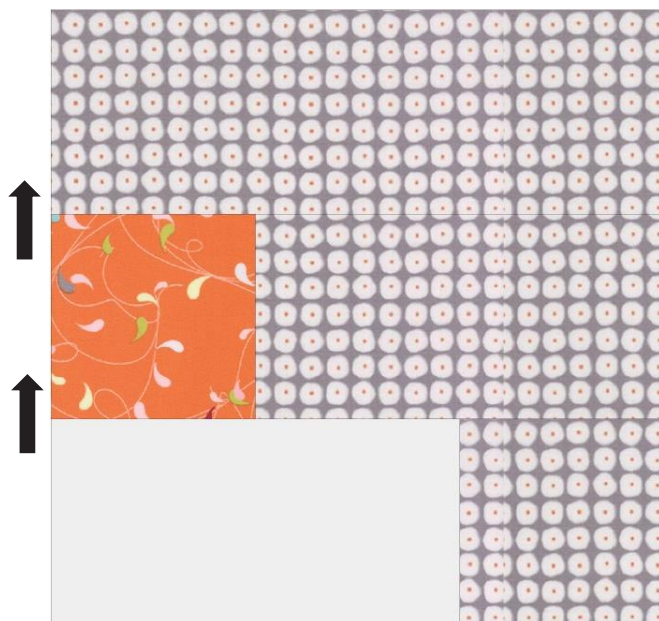


### Assembly for Block C

-Lay out one **Fabric 1** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle, one **Fabric 4** 2 ½" square, one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square, one **Fabric 4** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle and one **Fabric 4** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle as shown. Stitch together into rows, pressing towards **Fabric 4**.



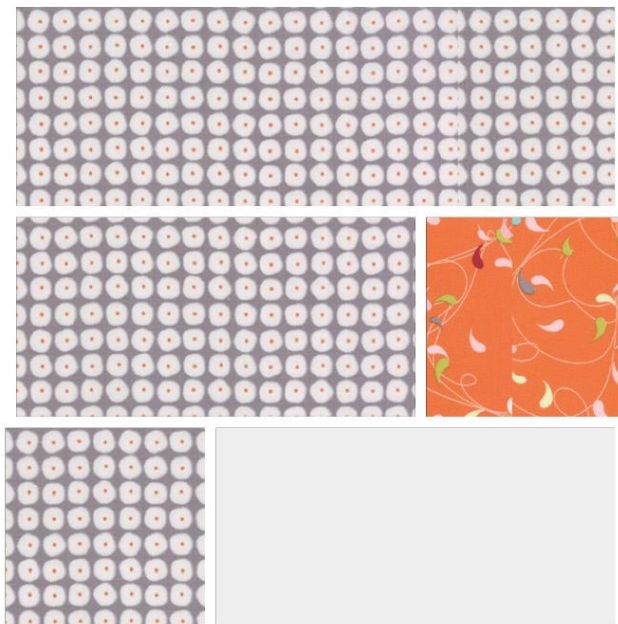
-Stitch the rows together, pressing in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 6 ½". Repeat to make four blocks.





### Assembly for Block D

-Lay out one **Fabric 4**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, one **Fabric 1**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, one **Fabric 4**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, one **Fabric 3**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square and one **Fabric 4**  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle as shown. Stitch together into rows, pressing towards **Fabric 4**.



-Stitch the rows together, pressing in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make four blocks.
