

# Windmills and Pinwheels

Block 3 with Applique

## Cutting Instructions:

### Fabric 2, cut:

(2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (16) 2 7/8" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (32) HST OR (use die #5 and cut (32) HST).

### Fabric 3, cut:

(1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 2 7/8" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (16) HST OR (use die #5 and cut (16) HST).

### Fabric 4, cut:

(1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 4 1/2" squares OR (use die #1 and cut (4) squares).

(2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (24) 2 7/8" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (48) HST OR (use die #5 and cut (48) HST).

(1) 6 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 6 3/4" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (8) HST.

### Fabric 6, cut:

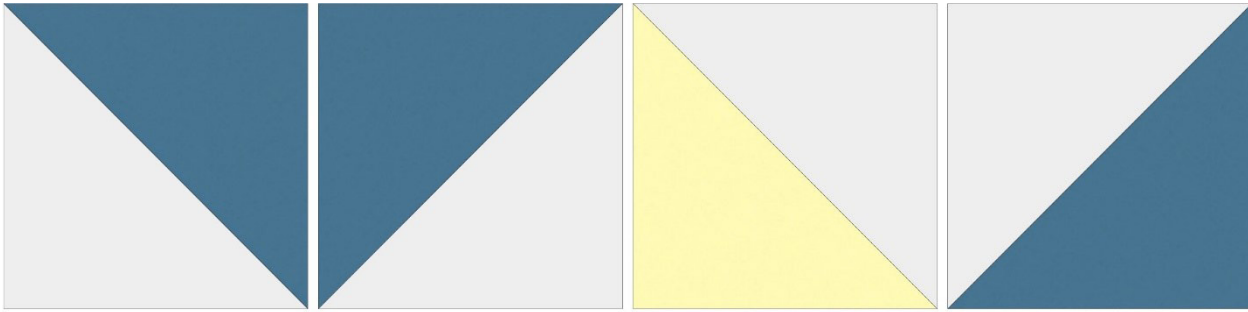
(1) 6 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 6 3/4" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (8) HST.

## Block 3 Construction:

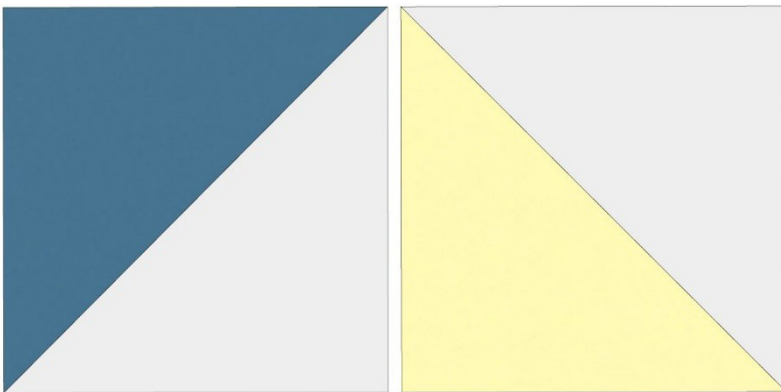
1. Print out the Daisy and Circle applique templates on the following pages (make sure to print at 100% scale) or use die Daisy (55327) and Circle (55484) to cut eight small daisy petals and one 1/2" circle. Using the block image as a guide, center the 1/2" circle on the 4 1/2" Fabric 4 square. Evenly space the small daisy petals around the circle, tucking the tip of the petal under the circle. Applique in place using your preferred applique stitch.
2. Sew a 2 7/8" Fabric 4 and Fabric 2 HST together. Press towards Fabric 2. Repeat to make (8) HST units.



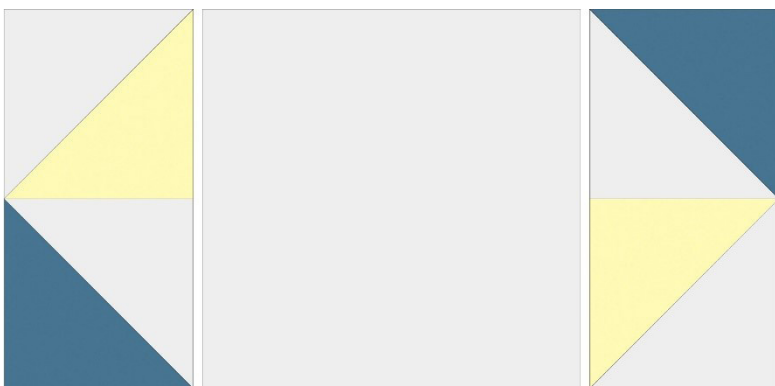
- Repeat the previous step with a 2 7/8" Fabric 4 and Fabric 3 HST. Press towards Fabric 3. Repeat to make (4) HST units.
- Lay out three Fabric 4/Fabric 2 and one Fabric 4/ Fabric 3 HST units as shown. Sew together into a row. Repeat to make a matching row.



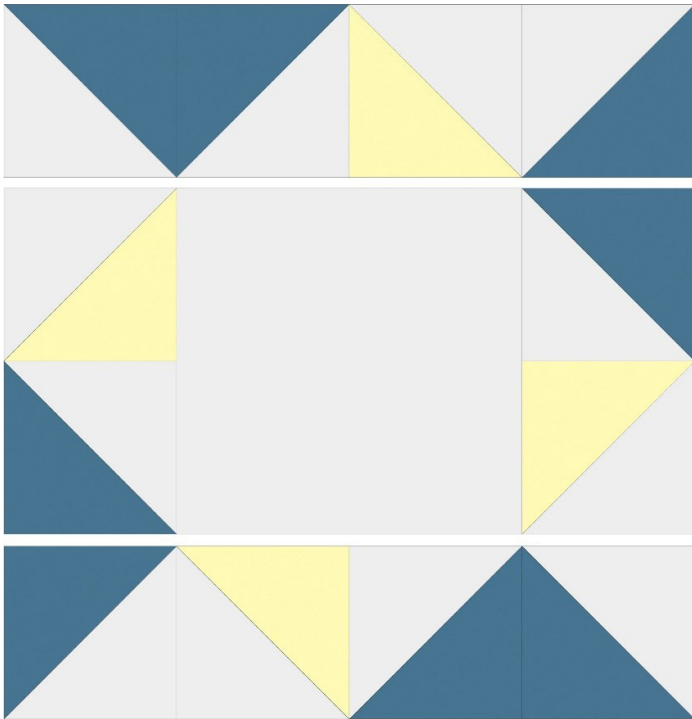
- Sew together one Fabric 4/ Fabric 2 and one Fabric 4/ Fabric 3 HST units as shown. Repeat to make a matching pair.



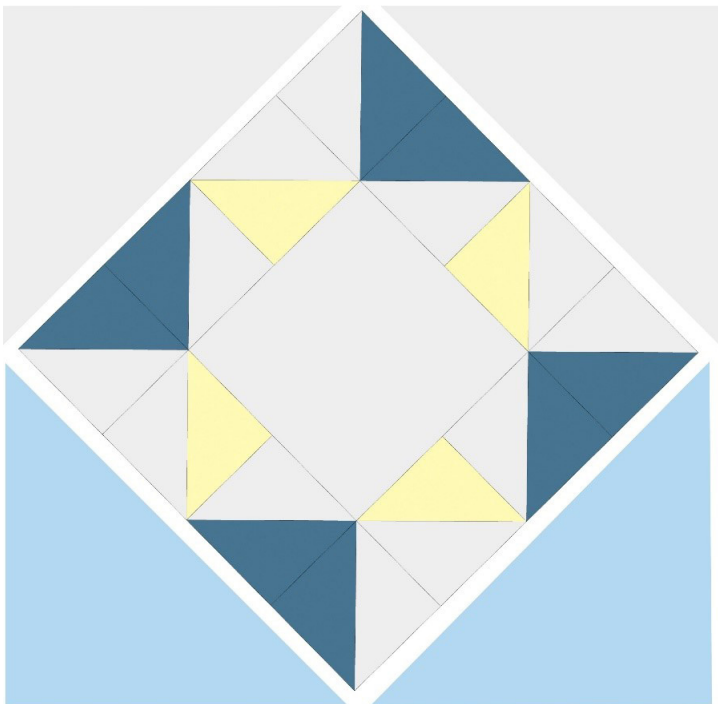
- Sew a HST pair to each side of the 4 1/2" Fabric 4 Appliqued square as shown.



7. Sew a HST row to the top and bottom of the previous unit.



8. Sew the (2)  $6\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric 4 and (2) Fabric 6 HST to the finished block as illustrated. Press to large triangles. Trim to  $11\frac{7}{8}$ " square. Repeat steps 1-8 to make (4) Block 3.

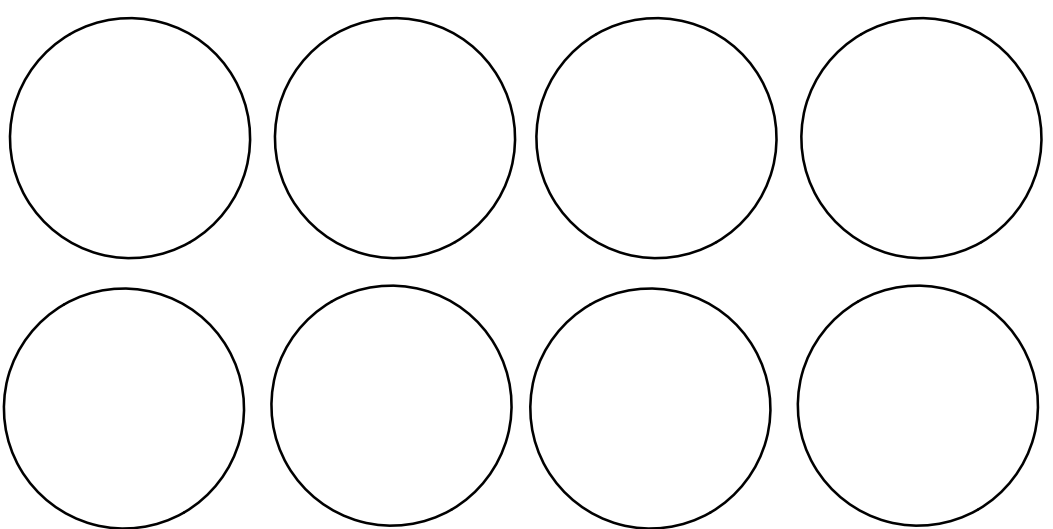
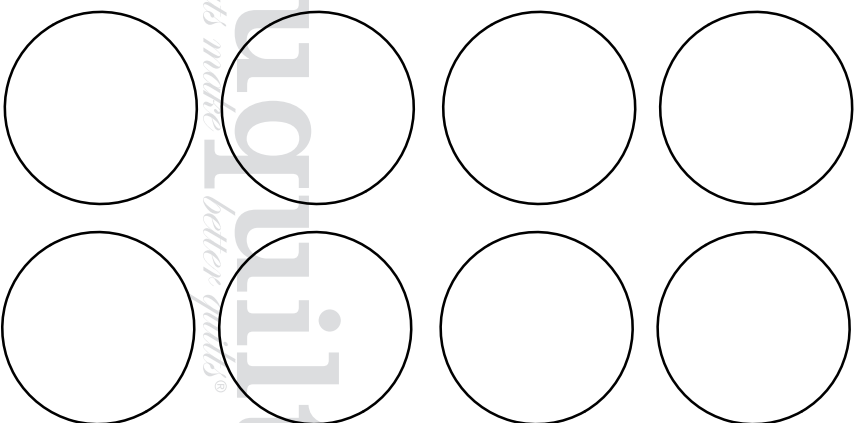
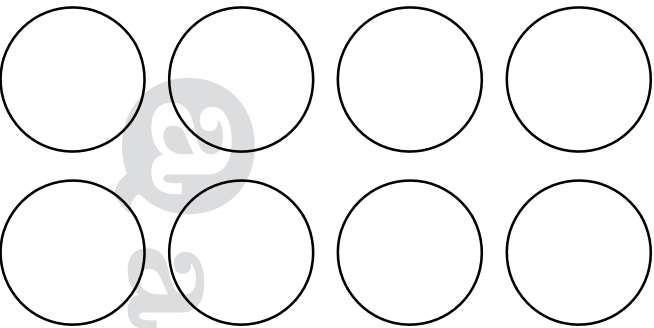
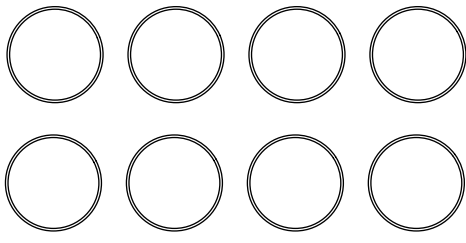
