

WINDMILLS AND PINWHEELS BLOCK 2

This block uses Fabrics 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 2 cut:

(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 2-1/2" squares.

OR (Use die #2 cut (8) squares.)

(For small quilt only) (1) 3-3/4" x WOF strip.

Sub-cut into (8) 3-3/4" squares.

OR (Use die #4 and cut (16) QST.)

Fabric 3 cut:

(1) 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 2-1/2" squares.

OR (Use die #2 cut (8) squares.)

(1) 3-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 3-3/4" squares.

OR (Use die #4 and cut (16) QST.)

Fabric 4 cut:

(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (16) 2-7/8" squares, then cut each once diagonally into (32) HST.

OR (Use die #5 cut (32) HST.)

(1) 6-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 6-3/4" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (8) HST.

Fabric 6 cut:

(1) 6-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (4) 6-3/4" squares and then cut each once diagonally into (8) HST.

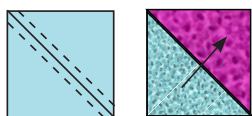
Fabric 7 cut: (Used in large quilt only)

(1) 3-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (8) 3-3/4" squares.

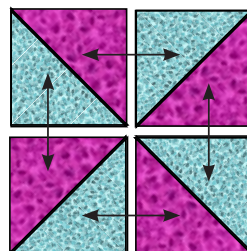
OR (Use die #4 and cut (16) QST.)

BLOCK 2 CONSTRUCTION

1. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the 3-3/4" **Fabric 7** squares (**Fabric 2** for small quilt). Place right sides together with a 3-3/4" **Fabric 3** square. Sew 1/4" on each side of the line.

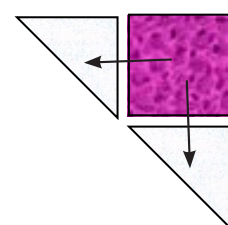
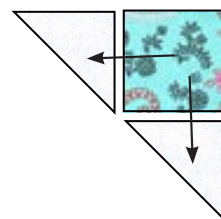


Cut along the drawn line. Press to darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/4" square. Make (4) HST units. **Skip this step for the die cut QST. Just sew the QSTs together.)**



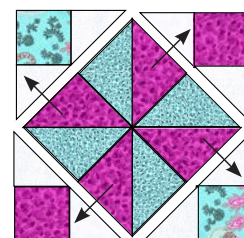
2. Sew the four HST units together into a Pinwheel block. Sew units across then sew rows together. Block should equal 6" square. Press seams **open**.

3. Sew a 2-7/8" **Fabric 4** HST to two sides of a 2-1/2" **Fabric 2** square. Press to triangles. Make (2) A Corner units.



4. Repeat step 3 with (2) 2-7/8" **Fabric 4** HST and 2-1/2" **Fabric 3** square. Make (2) B Corner units.

5. Sew the A and B Corner units to opposite sides of the Pinwheel block, matching points of squares to center of block. Press to Corner units. Block should equal 8-1/2" square.



6. Sew the (2) 6-3/4" **Fabric 4** and (2) **Fabric 6** HST to the finished block as illustrated. Press to large triangles. Trim to 11-7/8" square. Repeat steps 1- 6 to make (4) Block 2.
