

Instructions

WEEK 2 INSTRUCTIONS

Cut CB yarn. The next chart is worked with CA only.

Next Row (RS): With CA, k3, sm, yo, knit to next marker, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, knit to next marker, yo, sm, k3—4 sts inc; 201 sts.

Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

With CA, Work Chart B 3 times—24 rows total; 249 sts.

Note: Every RS row increases the shawl by 4 sts.

Reattach CB, and work Chart A 5 times—40 rows total; 329 sts.

Note: Every RS row increases the shawl by 4 sts

Next Row (RS): With CB, k3, sm, yo, knit to next marker, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, knit to next marker, yo, sm, k3—4 sts inc; 333 sts.


Next Row (WS): Knit all sts.

Key

- K on RS/P on WS
- P on RS/K on WS
- yo
- / m1R
- \ m1L
- st-rep
- stitch marker

Chart B

Note: Chart is worked entirely in CA.



Written Instructions for Chart B

Row 1 (RS): With CA, k3, sm, yo *k2, p2; rep from * to 1 st before marker, k1, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k1, **p2, k2; rep from ** to marker, yo, sm, k3—4 sts inc.

Row 2 (WS): K3, sm, p1 *p2, k2; rep from * to 2 sts before marker, p2, sm, k1, sm, p2, **k2, p2; rep from ** to 1 st before marker, p1, sm, k3.

Row 3: K3, sm, yo, knit to next marker, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, knit to next marker, yo, sm, k3—4 sts inc.

Row 4: Knit all sts.

Row 5: K3, sm, yo, k2, *p2, k2; rep from * to 3 sts before marker, p2, k1, m1R, sm, k1, sm, m1L, k1, p2, **k2, p2; rep from ** to 2 sts before marker, k2, yo, sm, k3—4 sts inc.

Row 6: K3, sm, p3, *k2, p2; rep from * to marker, sm, k1, sm, **p2, k2; rep from ** to 3 sts before marker, p3, sm, k3.

Row 7: Rep Row 3—4 sts inc.

Row 8: Knit all sts.

Rep Rows 1 – 8 for patt.

Special Abbreviations

cdd: central double decrease - slip first and second stitches together as if to knit them together, knit 1 stitch, pass two slipped stitches over the knit stitch.

m1L: with the left needle, make one left by lifting strand in between stitch just worked and the next stitch, bringing the needle from front to back and knitting it through the back loop.

m1R: with left needle, make 1 right by lifting strand in between stitch just worked and the next stitch, bringing the needle from the back to the front and knitting it.

Abbreviations

beg: beginning
BO: bind off
CO: cast on
CA: Color A
CB: Color B
inc: increase(d)
k: knit

p: purl
patt: pattern
pm: place marker
rep: repeat
RS: Right Side
sm: slip marker
sl: slip stitch purlwise

st(s): stitch(es)
WS: Wrong Side
wyif: with yarn in front
wyib: with yarn in back
yo: yarn over
