#### **TIPS FOR SUCCESS**

#### 1. WATCH THE EPISODE!

#### 3. GET YOUR MACHINE READY


Prepare for quilting success by ensuring that your machine needle is sharp. Are you experiencing breakage of your top thread, or skipped stitches? Do you hear a quiet popping sound when your needles move through the fabric? These are all signs that your needle is dull and it's time for a change.

## **TURN IN EARLY**


Quilting Diagram



The batik fabrics in this quilt are so bright and bold that any all-over quilting design will look great. I opted for a leafy meander since it fit the background print. It's also a great way to quickly work around your quilt. With this, as with any design, the trick is to use echoing to fill in any gaps in the design.

## **UP ALL NIGHT**

### Quilting Diagram



When working on quilts with triangles and squares, I usually resort to my go-to machine quilting technique, dot-to-dot quilting. It allows me to quilt intricate-looking designs with no marking! Try quilting wedges in the larger triangles and experiment with different continuous curve designs in the four-patch blocks.
