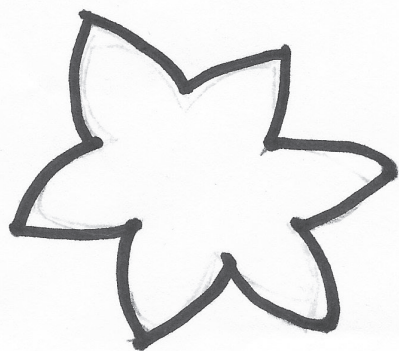


Materials Needed:

- 5" x 18" orange fabric
- 2 ½" square green wool
- 1 cup ground walnut shells
- pearl cotton
- 1 brown button

Directions:

1. Trace the template 6 times onto the orange fabric.
2. Cut the shapes and sew 2 together along one side.
3. Sew another shape onto the unit in the same way.
4. Make two sets of 3 each.
5. Turn one unit right side out and nest it inside the other unit.
6. Pin these units together and sew together leaving an opening for turning.
7. Using a small funnel, fill the fabric with ground walnut shells.
8. Sew the opening closed.
9. Cut the green wool using the template.
10. With a large eye needle, using the pearl cotton, sew through the pumpkin from top center to bottom center.
11. Repeat six times, nesting the thread into a seam each time.
12. Sew the brown button to the top securing the wool leaves under the button.
