Baskets and Blooms Finishing Instructions

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Background

Cut 3: 18-1/4" squares. Sub-cut each twice diagonally to create 12 QST. Set 2 aside.

Cut 2: 9-1/2" squares. Sub-cut each once diagonally to create 4 HST.

Dark Fabric

Cut 6: 2-1/4" x WOF strips for the binding

Optional border

Dark Fabric

Cut 6: 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1. Cut 8: 5-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3. Cut 8: 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.

Background

Cut 7: 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

Backing:

Without border: 3-1/2 yards (vertical seam) With border: 5 yards (horizontal seam)

Batting:

Without border: 58" x 75" With border: 73" x 90"

QUILT CONSTRUCTION

- 1. Following the quilt layout on the following page, layout the basket blocks, flower blocks, HSTs and QSTs in diagonal rows.
- 2. Sew blocks and triangles in diagonal rows, pressing each row in opposite directions.
- 3. Matching seams, sew rows together adding corner HSTs last. Trim edges if necessary.


OPTIONAL BORDER CONSTRUCTION

- 4. Sew the six 1-1/2" by WOF Dark strips short ends together.
- 5. Measure the quilt vertically (top to bottom) through the center and cut two Dark fabric strips to this measurement. Pin and sew to sides of quilt.
- 6 Measure the quilt horizontally (side to side) through the center and cut two Dark fabric strips to this measurement. Pin and sew to top and bottom.
- 7. Repeat steps 4, 5 and 6 with the 2-1/2" x WOF Background strips and 5-1/2" x WOF Dark Fabric strips.

FINISHING

- 8. Layer quilt, batting and pieced backing and quilt as desired.
- 9. Sew the 2-1/4" Dark fabric binding strips short ends together. Sew to front of quilt with a French binding technique. Turn to back and hand sew down. OR sew binding on by machine.
