## FABRIC CHOICES

The quilt designed uses 12 fabrics. I chose a light background, 4 shades of green (very light to very dark), 3 shades of red/pink, 2 shades of blue (light and dark), and 2 shades of yellow/gold. I used mostly solids but you can use anything you have in your stash and use as many fabrics as you want. Be creative!

## PIECING

## Piecing tips:

* All seams are sewn with $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. It is important to establish a consistent seam allowance. Try doing a test block first with some other fabric.
* WOF refers to "Width of Fabric".
* Press in the direction of the arrows.
* Cut larger pieces first in the same fabric color. The smaller pieces can be cut from the remainder.
* Keep all scraps! You may need them later.
* Use a "measure as you go" system. Measure each section pieced and make corrections before going to next section.
* The half-square triangles are overcut so that you can square them off to the finished size. You can make them by one of these methods: 1) Draw a line on the back of one of the squares and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line.

2) Place squares right sides together, cut in half diagonally and sew with $1 / 4$ " seam.

* There are a variety of ways to make Flying Geese units, Half-square triangle units, and Quarter-square triangle units. Make sure after the unit is completed you trim it to the size indicated.

## GENERAL PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

## HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES (HST)

A square, cut once diagonally into two triangles.


## QUARTER-SQUARE TRIANGLES (QST)

A square cut twice diagonally into four triangles.

FLYING GEESE (FG) Option 1
Is created with two half-square triangles (A) and one quarter-square triangle (B).


## FLYING GEESE (FG) Option 2

Is created with one rectangle and two squares. Draw diagonal lines on the backs of the squares (or press square in half diagonally). Sew on the line one side at a time and trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.


## DIAMOND IN A SQUARE

Is created with a square and four HSTs (A).

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Dark Red
Cut 1: 2-7/8" square
Light Blue
Cut 3: 3-3/8" squares
Medium Dark Green
Cut 1: 8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST (set one aside).
Dark Green
Cut 1:3-3/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST.
Background


Cut 3: 3-3/8" squares
Cut 1: 8 " square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST (set one aside).
Cut 2: $3^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut 1:5-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST (set one aside).

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Place a $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Light Blue square right sides together with a Background $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square. Cut in half diagonally into 2 HSTs and sew along the long edge (or draw a line and sew
 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line). Make 6 HST. Square to $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew the Background and Med. Dark Green 8" HST together. Press to Green. Square to 7-5/8".

3. Sew 3 Light Blue/Background HSTs together as illustrated.
4. Sew 3 Light Blue/Background HSTs together as illustrated with the 2-7/8"
 Dark Red square.

5. Sew the units from steps 2-4 as illustrated. Unit should equal 10".
6. Sew a Dark Green $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ HST to the end of one $3^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.

7. Sew the remaining Dark Green $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ HST to the end of the remaining $3^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.
8. Sew units from steps 6 and 7 to the block as illustrated.

9. Sew the $5-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Background HST to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2" square.

## Light Pink

Cut 1: 3-1/2" square
Cut 1: 3" square
Pink
Cut 2: 3-1/2" squares
Dark green
Cut 2: 3-1/2" squares.
Cut 1: 1-1/4" x 10 " strip.
Background


Cut 3: 3-1/2" squares
Cut 3: 3" squares
Cut 1:5-3/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST.
Cut 2: 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
Cut 2: 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Place a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Light Pink square right sides together with a $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background square. Cut in half diagonally into 2 HSTs (or draw a line and sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line). Sew along long edge. Make 2 HST units. Square to 3". Repeat with a 3-1/2" Pink and
 Background square. Make 2 HST units.
2. Repeat step 1 with a 3-1/2" Dark Green and Background square and a 3-1/2" Pink and Dark Green square. Make 2 of each.

3. Matching centers sew a $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Background HST to each side of the $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Dark Green rectangle. Trim corners and square to 5-1/2".
4. Sew a Background 3" square, a Pink/Background HST, a Dark green/Pink HST, and a Dark Green/Background HST together as shown. Unit should equal 5-1/2".

5. Repeat step 4 as shown.

6. Sew 2 Light Pink/Background HSTs, a 3" Light Pink and a Background square together as shown. Unit should equal 5-1/2".

7. Sew the units from steps $3,4,5$ and 6 together as shown. Sew the 2 Background $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to opposite sides. Then sew the 2 Background $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to the remaining sides.


Block should equal 12-1/2".

Cut 1: 4" square

Cut 1: 4" square

Cut 2: 4" squares
Dark Green
Cut 1: 3-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. Cut 1:3-1/2" square

## Blue

Cut 1: 6-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. (Set one aside.) Background
Cut 4: 4" squares.
Cut 1: 3-7/8" square.
Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST.
Cut 1: 6-7/8" square. Sub-cut
once diagonally into 2 HST.


Set one aside.
Cut 2: $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Make the following HSTs using the 4 " squares, by placing them right sides together and cutting into HST or drawing a line and sewing $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line. Square to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

2. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the Dark Green $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place it right sides together on the corner of the 6-7/8" Blue HST. Sew on the drawn line. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.

3. Sew a Dark Green 3-7/8" HST to the end of one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.
4. Sew the remaining Dark Green 3-7/8" HST to the end of the remaining $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.
5. Sew the units from step 1 together with the 2
Background 3-7/8" HSTs. Sew HSTs together, then sew rows together.

6. Matching centers, sew the Blue/Green HST unit to the corner. Unit should equal 9-1/2".


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
