CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Yellow

Cut 1: 4-7/8" square.

Sub-cut once diagonally into

2 HST. Set one aside.

Gold

Cut 2: 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Dark Blue

Cut 4: 3" squares

Cut 1: 2-1/2" square

Cut 1: 4-7/8" square.

Sub-cut once diagonally into

2 HST. Set one aside

Dark Green

Cut 1: 2-7/8" square. Sub-cut

once diagonally into 2 HST.

Background

Cut 4: 3" squares

Cut 3: 2-1/2" squares.

Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle


Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle

Cut 2: 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Cut 1: 4-7/8" square. Sub-cut

once diagonally into 2 HST.

Set one aside



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Make 8 HSTs using the 3" Dark Blue with the 3" Background squares using your favorite method. Square to 2-1/2".




Make 8



2. Sew a Dark Blue 4-7/8" HST to a Yellow 4-7/8" HST. Unit should equal 4-1/2".

3. Sew a Background 2-1/2" \times 4-1/2" rectangle to the right side of the Dark Blue/Yellow HST and the Background 2-1/2" \times 6-1/2" rectangle to the top.













4. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of two 2-1/2" Background squares. Using the flip and sew method, place them right sides together on the ends of the two 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Gold rectangles as shown to create a left and right unit. Units should equal 2-1/2" x 6-1/2".

5. Sew the left unit shown from step 4 to the left side of the unit from step 3.





6. Sew a Dark Blue 2-1/2" square to the left side of the remaining unit from step 4.

7. Sew the unit from step 6 to the bottom of unit from step 5.





8. Sew 4 Dark Blue/Background HST together. Make 2 sets.



9. Sew a Background 2-1/2" square to the right side of the HST set as shown.





10. Sew the sets from steps 8 and 9 to the block as shown.


11. Sew a Dark Green 2-7/8" HST to the end of one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Background rectangle as illustrated.




12. Sew the remaining Dark Green 2-7/8" HST to the end of the remaining 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Background rectangle as illustrated.



- 13. Sew units from steps 11 and 12 to the block as illustrated.
- 14. Sew the 4-7/8" Background HST to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2".

Cut 1: 3-1/2" square *Medium Green*

Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 5" rectangle

Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 7" rectangle

Dark Green

Cut 2: 2-1/2" x 7" rectangles

Cut 1: 2-1/2" square

Background

Cut 6: 2-1/2" squares

Cut 1: 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle


Cut 1: 2" x 5" rectangle

Cut 1: 2-1/4" x 9" rectangle

Cut 1: 2-1/4" x 10-1/2" rectangle

Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle




SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Sew the Background $2'' \times 3-1/2''$ rectangle to the top of the Pink 3-1/2'' square. Then sew the $2'' \times 5''$ rectangle to the right side.





2. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of two 2-1/2" Background squares. Using the flip and sew method, place one right sides together on the end of the 2-1/2" x 5" Medium Green rectangle as shown to create a right unit. Unit should equal 2-1/2" x 5".










4. Sew the left and right units from steps 2 and 3 to the step 1 unit as. illustrated. Unit should equal 7".








6. Sew one step 5 unit to the bottom side of the block.

7. Sew the 2-1/2" Dark Green square to one end of the step 5 unit.

Sew this to the left side of the block as illustrated.

Unit should equal 9".







8. Sew a 2-1/4" x 9" rectangle to the right side of the block.






9. Sew a 2-1/4" x 10-1/2" rectangle to the top of the block.

10. Sew a 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle to the left side of the block.





11. Sew a 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of the block. Block should equal 12-1/2".

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Pink

Cut 2: 3-3/8" squares

Red

Cut 3: 3-3/8" squares

Light Pink

Cut 1: 3-3/8" square

Dark Green

Cut 1: 3-3/8" square. Sub-cut

once diagonally into 2 HST.

Dark Blue

Cut 1: 8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST.

Set one aside.

Background

Cut 5: 3-3/8" squares

Cut 2: 3-1/4" squares. Sub-cut each once diagonally into 4 HST.


Set one aside.

Cut 2: 3" x 7-1/2" rectangles

Cut 1: 5-7/8" square. Sub-cut

once diagonally into 2 HST.

Set one aside.



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Make the following HSTs using the 3-3/8" squares using your favorite method. Square to 2-7/8".






Make 3

- 2. Sew the sets together from step 1 along with the three 3-1/4" Background HSTs.
- 3. Matching centers, sew the 8" Dark Blue HST to the set from step 2.





- 4. Sew a dark green 3-3/8" HST to the end of one 3" x 7-1/2" background rectangle as illustrated.
- 5. Sew the remaining Dark green 3-3/8" HST to the end of the remaining 3" x 7-1/2" Background rectangle as illustrated.
- 6. Sew units from steps 4 and 5 to the block as illustrated. Then sew the 5-7/8" background HST to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2".
