## Block 10

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Yellow
Cut 1:4-7/8" square.
Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. Set one aside.
Medium Green
Cut 2: 4-7/8" squares. Sub-cut each once diagonally into 4 HST. Set one aside.
Dark Red
Cut 1: 3-7/8" square.
Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST.
Pink
Cut 4: 3" squares

## Dark Green

Cut 1: 2-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. Background
Cut 4: 3" squares
Cut 1: $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square
Cut 1: 2-1/2" square
Cut 1: $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut 1: $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut 2: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut 1:4-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. Set one aside.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Make 8 HSTs using the $3^{\prime \prime}$ Pink with the $3^{\prime \prime}$ Background squares using your favorite method. Square to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

2. Sew a Medium Green 4-7/8" HST to a Yellow 4-7/8" HST. Unit should equal 4-1/2".
3. Sew the two 3-7/8" Dark Red HSTs to 2 sides of the 3-1/2" Background square as illustrated.

4. Sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle to the right side of the unit from step 3. Then sew the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle to the top.
5. Trim the excess of the Background strips to be even with the edge of the Dark Red HSTs.
6. Sew 4 Pink/Background HSTs together. Make 2 sets as
 illustrated.

7. Sew a Background 2-1/2" square to the right side of the HST set as shown.
8. Sew the two Medium Green 4-7/8" HSTs to the sides of the Medium Green/Yellow HST.


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9. Sew the unit from step 5 to the unit from step 8.

10. Sew the pieced HST units from steps 6 and 7 to the right side and top of the block as illustrated.
11. Sew a Dark Green 2-7/8" HST to the end of one $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.

12. Sew the remaining Dark Green $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ HST to the end of the remaining $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.

13. Sew units from steps 11 and 12 to the block as illustrated.
14. Sew the 4-7/8" Background HST to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2".

## Yellow

Cut 1:3" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ square
Light Green
Cut 1: 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle
Cut 1: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle Pink
Cut 1: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

## Medium Green

Cut 1: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle Cut 1: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle Background
Cut 1: 2-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle Cut 1: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut 4: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut 2: $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut 1: 2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
Cut 1: 2" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle


## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Sew the 2 " $x 3^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle to the top of the $3 " x 3^{\prime \prime}$ yellow square.

2. Sew the 2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle to the right side of the Yellow square. Unit should equal 4-1/2".
3. Draw a diagonal line on the backs of the 2-1/2" Background squares. Using the flip and sew method, place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background square right
 sides together on the right end of the 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Pink rectangle as shown. Sew and trim to create a right unit. Unit should equal $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Repeat step 3 with a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background square and the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Pink rectangle as shown to create a left unit. Unit should equal 2-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
5. Sew the left and right units from steps 3 and 4 to the block as shown. Unit should equal 6-1/2" square.

6. Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle right sides together on the right end of the 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Light Green rectangle as shown. Draw a 45 degree line from the corner of the Background rectangle as illustrated. Sew on the drawn line and trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward Light Green to create a right unit.
7. Place a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle rights sides together on the left end of the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Light Green rectangle as shown. Repeat the steps from step 6 to create a left unit.


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8. Sew the left and right units from steps 6 and 7 to the block as shown. Unit should equal 8-1/2" square.
9. Repeat step 6 with the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Background rectangle and the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Medium Green rectangle to create a right unit.

10. Repeat step 7 with the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle and the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Medium Green rectangle to create a left unit.
11. Sew the left and right units from steps 9 and 10 to the block as shown. Unit should equal 10-1/2" square.
12. Sew the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background rectangles to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2" square.

Cut 3: 3-3/8" squares
Medium Green
Cut 2: 2-7/8" x 5-1/4" rectangles
Cut 1:3-3/8" square
Dark Green
Cut 2: 3-3/8" squares. Sub-cut one square once diagonally to create 2 HST.

## Background

Cut 4: 3-3/8" squares
Cut 3: 2-7/8" squares
Cut 1: 2-7/8" x 5-1/4" rectangle
Cut 2: 3" $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Cut 1:5-7/8" square. Sub-cut once diagonally into 2 HST. Set one aside.

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS (Press in the direction of the arrows.)

1. Make the following HSTs using the $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Pink squares with the $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Background squares, a 3-3/8" Red square with the 3-3/8" Background square and a 3-3/8" Dark Green square with a $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Medium Green square using your favorite method. Square to 2-7/8".

2. Sew a Background 2-7/8" square to the right side of the Red 2-7/8" square. Then sew the 2-7/8" $\times 5-1 / 4$ " Background rectangle to the top as shown. Unit should equal $5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square.
3. Draw a line on the backs of two 2-7/8" Background squares. Using the flip and sew method, place a Background square on the ends of the two $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Medium Green rectangles to create
 the left and right unit shown. Units should equal $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.

4. Sew the right unit to the step 2 unit.
5. Sew the Medium Green/Dark Green HST to the end of the left unit as illustrated.

6. Sew the left pieced unit to the block as illustrated. Unit should equal $7-5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ square.
7. Sew sets of 3 Pink/Background HSTs together as shown to create a left and right unit.


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8. Sew the right unit to the block as shown.
9. Sew a Red/Background HST to the left unit as shown.

10. Sew the left pieced HST unit from step 9 to the top of the block. Unit should equal 10 " square.
11. Sew a Dark Green $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ HST to the end of one $3^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.

12. Sew the remaining Dark Green $3-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ HST to the end of the remaining $3^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background rectangle as illustrated.

13. Sew units from steps 11 and 12 to the block as illustrated.

14. Sew the $5-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Background HST to the block. Block should equal 12-1/2".
