

Fabric Requirements (Based on 40"-42" of usable fabric)

Approximately 1/8 yard 'extra' of each fabric added to requirements

Fabric 1 (Light Grey): **1 yard**

Fabric 2 (Teal print): **1 yard**

Fabric 3 (Orange print): $\frac{3}{4}$ **yard**

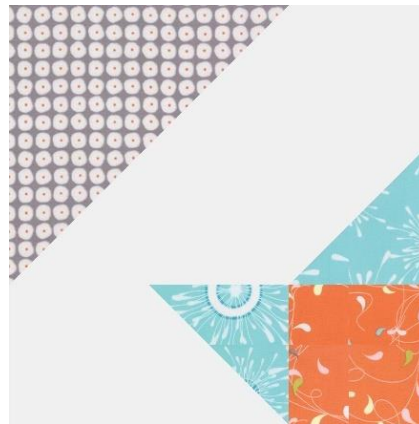
Fabric 4 (Background print): **2 yards**

Week 1

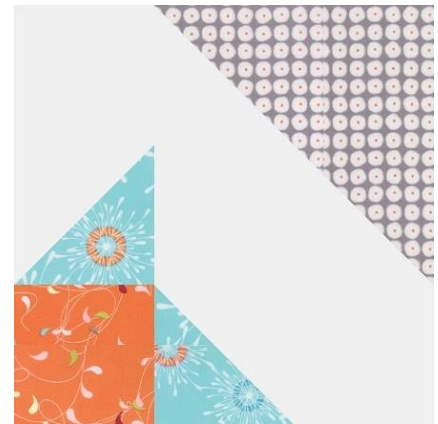
Block A (Make 4)



Block B (Make 2)

Cutting Instructions are for all Week 1 Blocks (A, B and C)

From **Fabric 1**, cut:

-(**2**) 2 ½" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (**20**) 2 ½" squares and (**4**) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

-(**2**) 3" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (**16**) 3" squares

From **Fabric 2**, cut:

-(4) 2 ½" squares

-(1) 3" x WOF strip, then sub-cut into (8) 3" squares

From **Fabric 3**, cut:

-(1) 3" x WOF strips, then sub-cut into (8) 3" squares

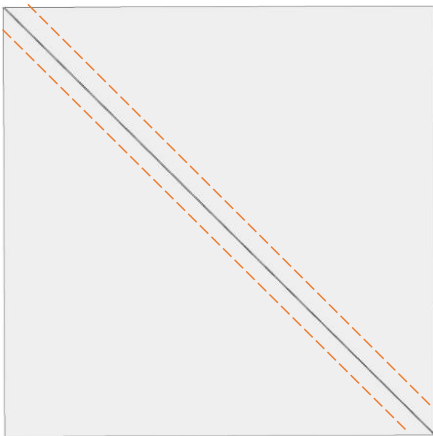
-(4) 2 ½" squares

From **Fabric 4**, cut:

-(1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, then sub-cut into (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles and (4) 2 ½" squares

Half Square Triangles

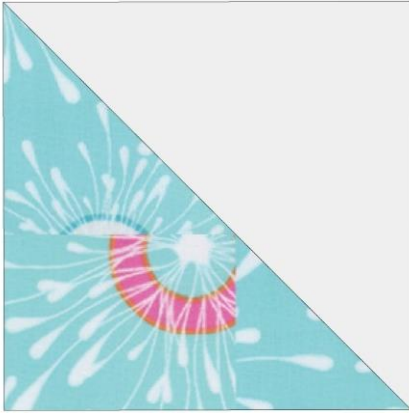
-On the wrong side of a **Fabric 1** 3" square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place a marked **Fabric 1** 3" square and a **Fabric 2** 3" square right sides together. Stitch ¼" on both sides of the marked line and then cut apart along the marked line. Press towards the darker fabric to create a Half Square Triangle (HST). Trim HST to 2 ½".



Solid line = Marked Line

Dashed line= Stitching Line

-Repeat to make **(16) Fabric 1/Fabric 2** HSTs and then repeat again to make **(16) Fabric 1/Fabric 3** HSTs.

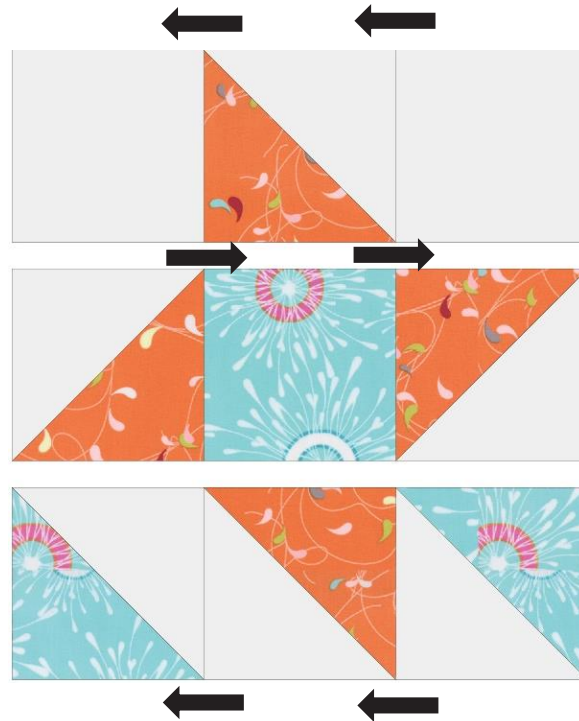


Assembly for Block A

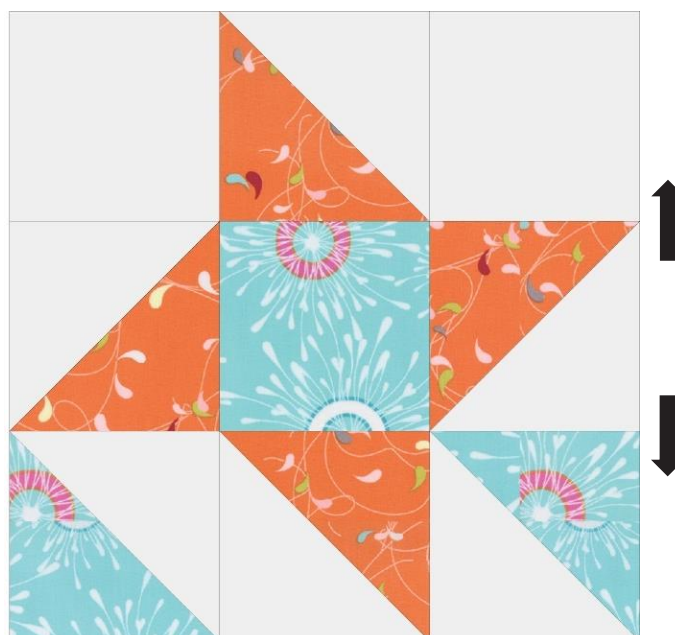
-Lay out two **Fabric 1/Fabric 2** HSTs, four **Fabric 1/Fabric 3** HSTs, one **Fabric 2** 2 1/2" square and two **Fabric 1** 2 1/2" squares as shown.



-Stitch together into rows, pressing in the direction of the arrows.

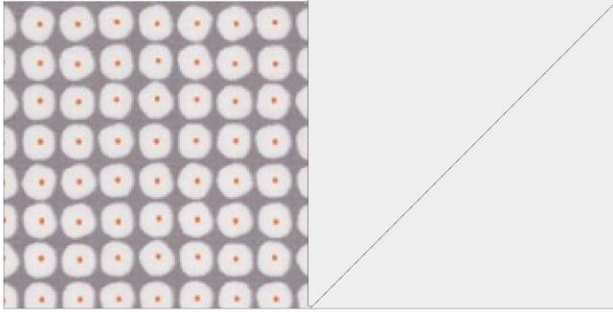


-Stitch the rows together, pressing in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 6 1/2". Repeat to make four blocks.

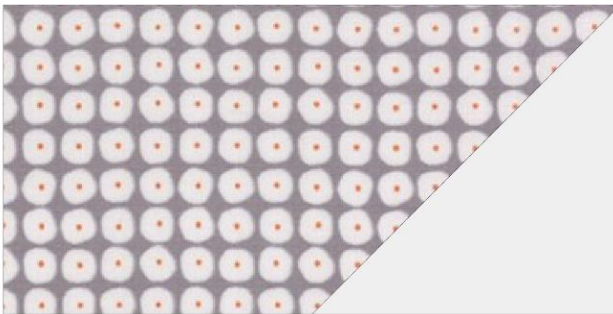


Half Flying Geese Units

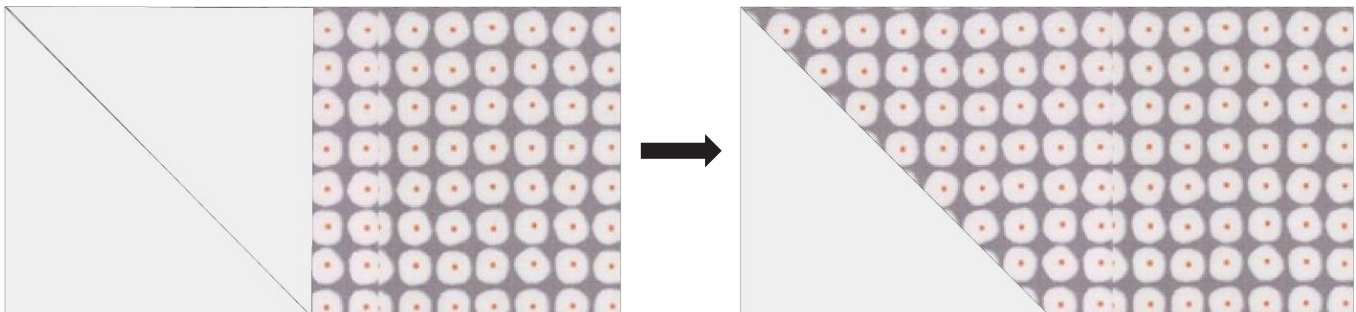
-On the wrong side of a **Fabric 1** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Place the marked **Fabric 1** square on the **right** side of a **Fabric 4** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle with right sides together.



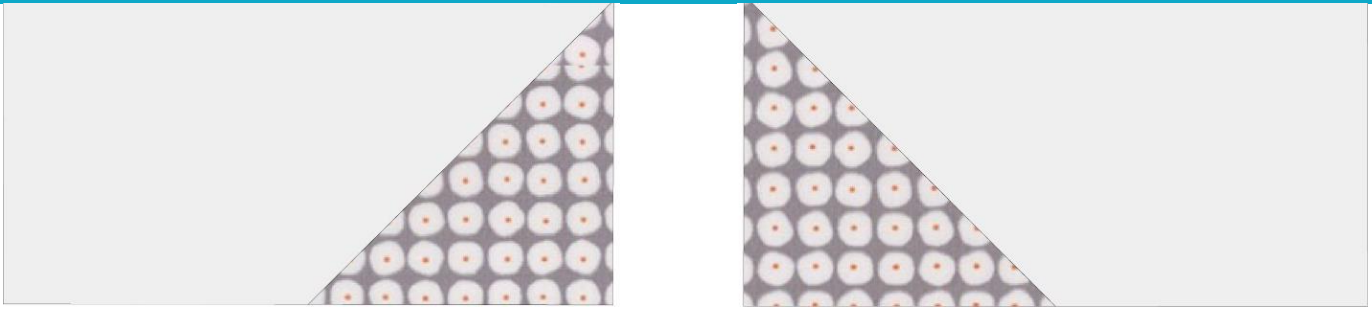
-Stitch on the marked line and then trim the seam allowance to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press towards **Fabric 1** to form a Half Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make one more.



-Repeat the above steps to make two Half Flying Geese Units with a **Fabric 1** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on the **left** side of a **Fabric 4** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.



-Repeat the above steps again, using four **Fabric 1** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles and four **Fabric 4** $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make two **right** and two **left** Half Flying Geese Units.

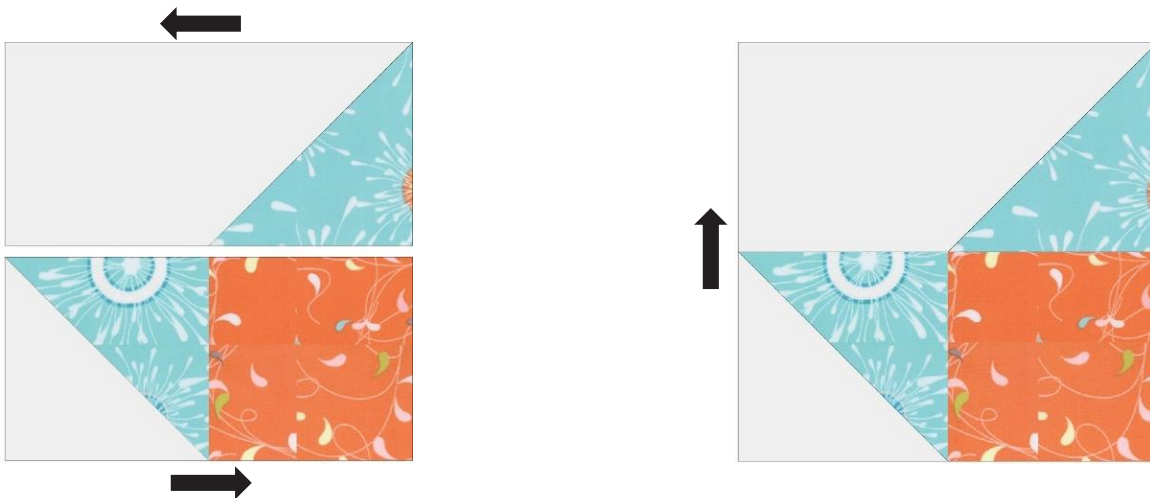


Assembly for Block B

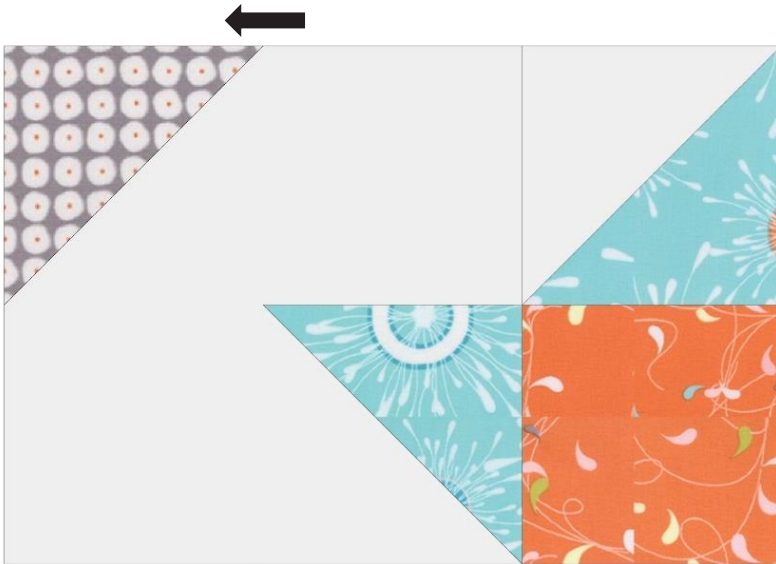
-Lay out two Half Flying Geese Units, two **Fabric 1** 2 ½" squares, two **Fabric 1/Fabric 2** HSTs and one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square as shown.



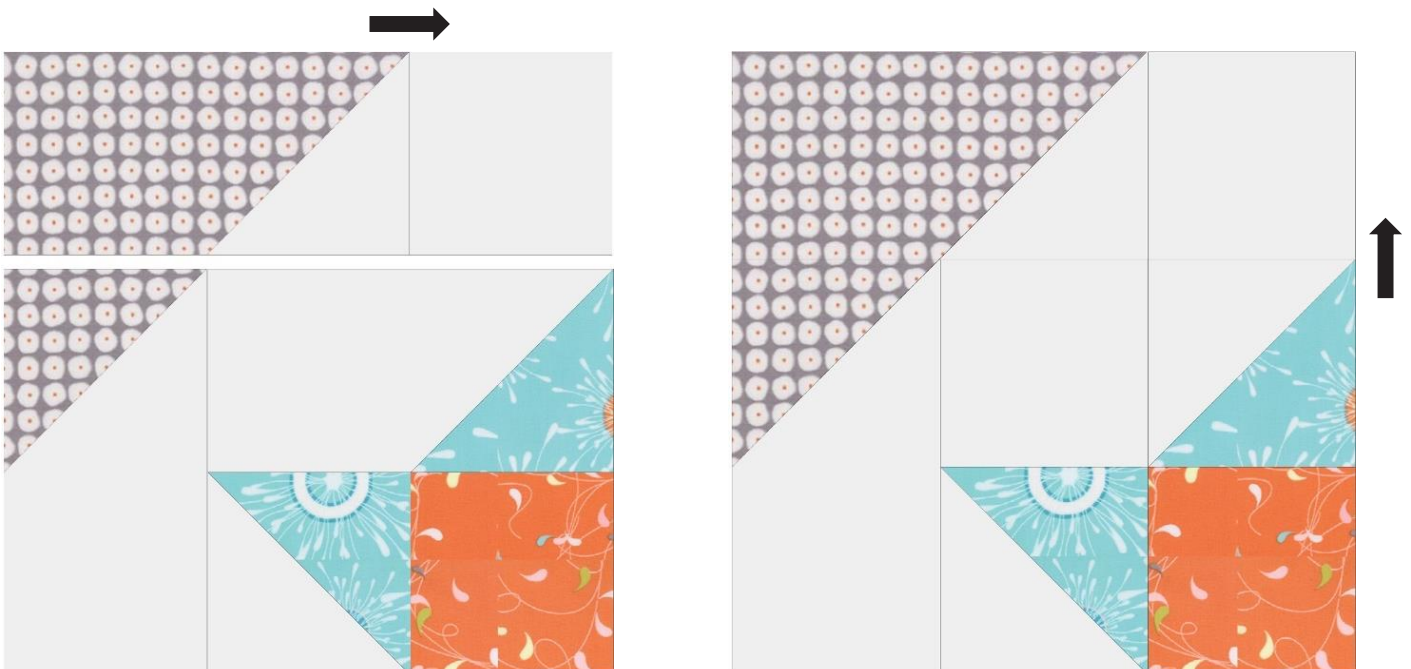
-Stitch the **Fabric 1** 2 ½" square, the two HSTs and the **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square together into pairs and then stitch the pairs together. Press in the direction of the arrows.



-Stitch one Half Flying Geese Unit to the left side of the pieces from the previous step. Press in the direction of the arrow.

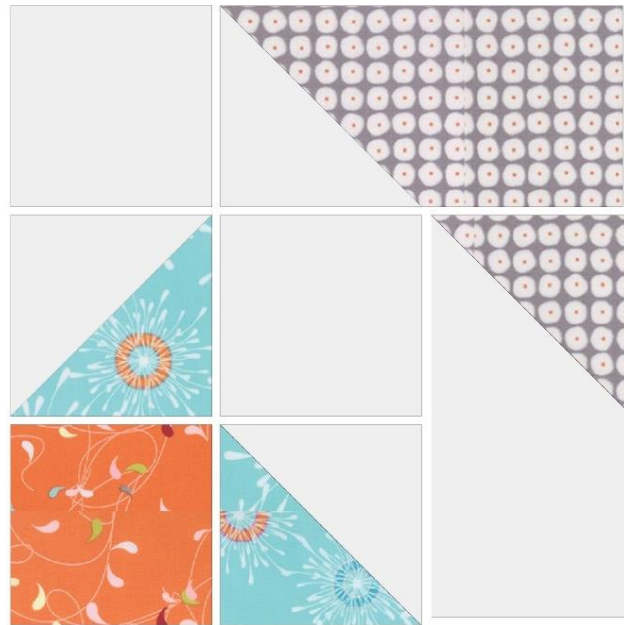


-Stitch one Half Flying Geese Unit and one **Fabric 1** 2 ½" square together as shown and then stitch to the top of the pieces from the previous step. Press in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 6 ½". Repeat to make two blocks.

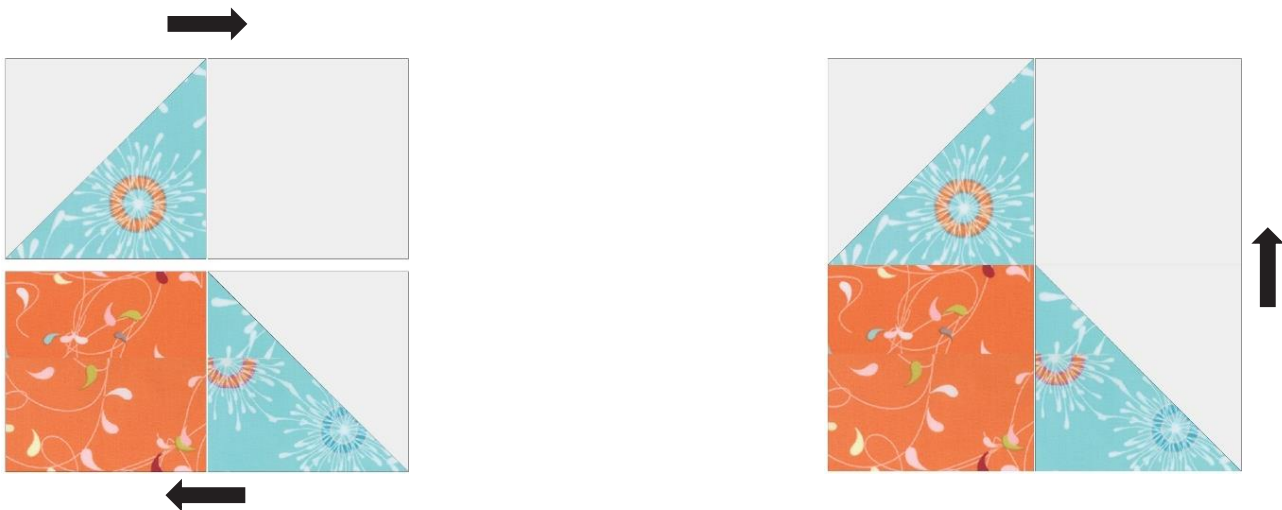


Assembly for Block C

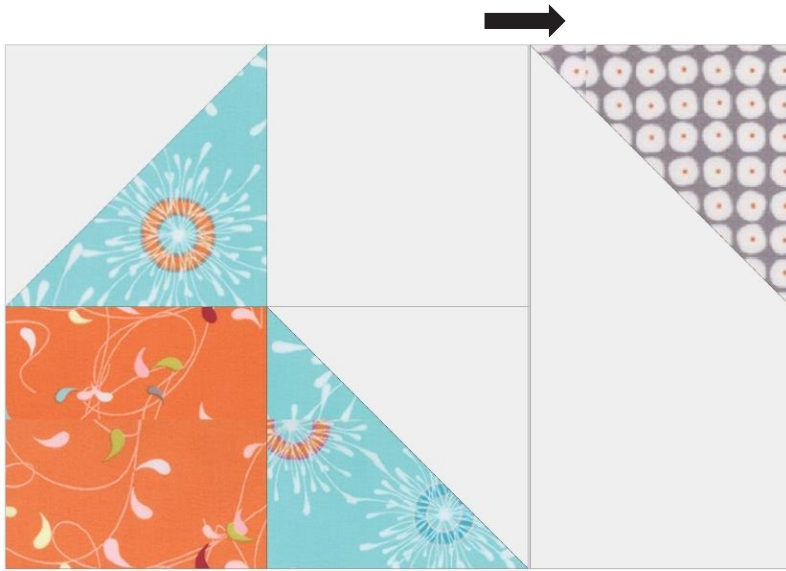
-Lay out two Half Flying Geese Units, two **Fabric 1** 2 ½" squares, two **Fabric 1/Fabric 2** HSTs and one **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square as shown.



-Stitch the **Fabric 1** 2 ½" square, the two HSTs and the **Fabric 3** 2 ½" square together into pairs and then stitch the pairs together. Press in the direction of the arrows.



-Stitch one Half Flying Geese Unit to the right side of the pieces from the previous step. Press in the direction of the arrow.



-Stitch one Half Flying Geese Unit and one **Fabric 1 2 1/2** square together as shown and then stitch to the top of the pieces from the previous step. Press in the direction of the arrows. Block should measure 6 1/2". Repeat to make two blocks.
